- 1. Principal Dr. A. M. Kate welcomed all members. The member secretary Dr. P. P. Walvekar presented the agenda items for discussion.
- 2. Dr. P. P. Walvekar presented the review of previous meeting.
- 3. As per the recommendations in last meeting, startup and innovation cell has been established in June 2019. The college level startup and innovation competition was organized under this cell in October 2019 and 11 project groups participated in this competition.
- 4. As per the recommendations in last meeting, 175 and 195 students across all departments were trained for python training and Japanese language respectively in semester I of A.Y. 2019-20.
- 5. Dr. A. M. Kate proposed to apply for programs in emerging areas with effect from AY 2020-21. After a thorough discussion, it was decided to apply for two additional programs; Robotics and Automation, Artificial Intelligence and Data Science by surrendering Mechanical Engineering (Shift-II) intake of 120. It was also decided to apply for PG program in Data Sciences by surrendering Computer Engineering.
- Mr. B. P. Shinde recommended providing skill development programs related to laser cutting machine and CNC wood routing machine. After taking positive consent from all members, Mr. P. V. Khandve agreed to do so in A.Y. 2020-21.
- 7. Dr. S. D. Shirbahadurkar attracted the attention of all members towards the issue of submitting monthly research report by faculty members. The issue was thoroughly discussed by all members and confirmed to provide amendment to research policy. It is decided unanimously to cancel submission of monthly research report and to publish at least two research papers.
- 8. Mr. L. M. Mahale suggested to organize national level hackathon based on current issues. All members agreed to organize the event in A.Y. 2019-20.
